



## Congress Theme: Diversity in Harmony: Insights from Psychology

Today, diversity in our world can be seen as both problematic and beneficial. For example, diversity can be related to ethnicity and culture, as well as physical attributes and health. There is also diversity among various domains of the field of psychology. The term 'harmony' is derived from Greek words meaning "joint, agreement, concord" and "to fit together, to join, " and is most often used in music to indicate different tones make a pleasing or striking sound when played together. Opening ceremony of National Academy of Psychology, Bhopal, India in December 2014

Professor Kazuo Shigemasu, president of the ICP2016 organizing committee, and Professor Takao Sato, president of the Japanese Psychological Association, were recently invited to India to attend the annual convention of the National Academy of Psychology (NAOP), which was held in December 2014 in Bhopal. They very much appreciated the hospitality and attentiveness of the past president of NAOP, Janak Pandey; the current president, Professor Purnima Singh; chief organizer of the NAOP conference, Professor Rehka Singhal; and many others.

A conference session was devoted to a presentation about ICP2016, during which Professors Shigemasu and Sato encouraged the audience to visit Yokohama in 2016. Professor Shigemasu pointed out that there may be some truth in the observation that Indian as well as Japanese psychologists have been looking only to the West for topics or theoretical frameworks for initiating research, and stressed that ICP2016 will offer a unique opportunity to learn from psychologists from all over the world.

Japanese Psychological Association officials plan to visit other countries to promote ICP2016.
