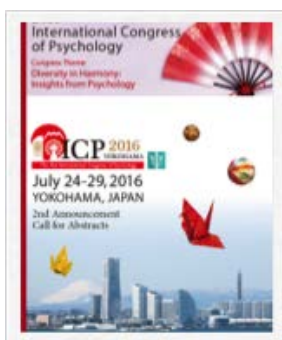
Diversity in Harmony: Insights from Psychology
