Hakone Barrier

The Hakone Barrier, created in 1619, when the Tokugawa Shogunate divided the country into 53 regions, was the most famous barrier in Japan. A monument marks its former site, and a replica of the barrier guardhouse has been built nearby. The Hakone Checkpoint Museum displays weapons, armor, old documents and other historical materials relating to the Hakone Barrier.

Lake Ashi

Excursion boats give cruises around beautiful Lake Ashi, a crater lake with a circumference of nearly 18 kilometers. Lake Ashi is also well known for the inverted reflection of Mount Fuji on a calm, clear day.

The Komagatake Ropeway

The Ropeway takes the visitor to the top of Mount Komagatake, which affords a view of Mount Fuji, Lake Ashi, Mount Futago and the mountains of the distant Izu Peninsula. Cable cars travel the 720-meter-long ropeway in five minutes.
