The International Association of Applied Psychology will be hosting an innovative virtual event, *Early Career Marathon: Integrating Research and Practice*. This will be a 24-hour event starting at 8:00 AM UTC on October 16th and concluding at 8:00 AM UTC on October 17th.

The marathon will feature presentations from early career psychologists – individuals with less than 10 years of professional experience – on their research, with a review and response from an established psychologist.
