The International Union of Psychological Science, the global voice of Psychology, is pleased to issue a call for nominations for its five prestigious global awards.



Lifetime Career Award

Honors distinguished and enduring lifetime contributions to international cooperation and advancement of knowledge in the field of psychological science.

Major Advancement in Psychological Science Prize

Recognizes a contribution that represents a major advancement in psychological science by a scholar or team of scholars of high international reputation.

Archbishop Desmond Tutu Achievement Against the Odds Award

Honours a researcher or team of researchers who succeeded in conducting research in psychological science under extremely difficult circumstances.

Young Investigator Award: Basic Science

Recognizes a significant contribution to psychological science by young post-doctoral scientists. There are separate awards for Basic and Applied Science.

Young Investigator Award: Applied Science

Recognizes a significant contribution to psychological science by young post-doctoral scientists. There are separate awards for Basic and Applied Science.



Each award is considered by a separate independent global jury of distinguished psychological scientists. Nominations and decision-making are confidential to those juries.

Only National Members can submit nominations for the Awards and the IUPsyS Secretariat is responsible for administration of the process.
